Tickets are available from the front office, payment can be made using EFTPOS or cash. Sales will be on a first in first served basis and we will not be able to reserve tickets or accept online (POP) payments for tickets. Tickets will be \$5 per seat, four years upwards. Tiny tots can be seated on parent's lap, but are not to stand up throughout the performance. We also advise, prams or strollers are not permitted in the hall due to WHS restrictions. All aisles and walkways must be kept clear at all times as students will be accessing these areas throughout the performances.
